MINUTES

October 20, 2010

Meeting

Larry Tucker, President called the meeting to order at 7:10 pm; with 20 members in attendance.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

June Opsitnick, Secretary handed out the minutes in advance to members from the September 15, 2010 meeting. Minutes were reviewed and accepted as presented.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Ray Racicot reported as of 10-20-10 the balance in the club account is as follows:

General Fund	\$ 8,600.00
Trail Fund	1,565.00
SAM permits	<u>3,000.00</u>
Total	\$ 13,165.00

Ray stated the club parked 607 cars during the Belchertown Fair which amounted to \$3,035; over \$823 from prior year. Ray continued advising the members 60 raffle tickets have been sold to date. This amount covers the cash prizes; we need \$1,000 to cover all costs.

Also, per registry we do not need block letters for the snowmobiles.

Motion was made and accepted to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

Belchertown Fair:

Larry thanked the good crew of volunteers who helped park cars at the fair and who were there for Monday's cleanup (which was noted by the fair group as a great job).

Mike Loftus mentioned next year we might have auxiliary parking on Saturday only; more information will follow. Suggestion was made for a float in next year's parade. Discussion on this subject will be at a future meeting.

Trail maps were requested at the fair and a decision was made to have maps made up and included in the newsletter and be at locations where memberships and trail passes are sold.

Larry stated Flamingo will be having their Open House Sunday, November 7th and those wishing to help us out at our booth to complete the sign up sheet. Raffle tickets, memberships, and Ski Doo promotion forms will be available at the open house.

Trails:

- Rt. 202 scales to Jackson Street is a go; bridge needed, trail to be cut and will not be on rail bed
- Bill Lyons stated the club can be reimbursed by the BLT for time spent on the trails
- Crew is required to help clear trail and contractors are needed for stumping and grating
- Date for clearing will be Sunday September 24th or 31st; meet at Hawley's in Belchertown at 8:00 am
- Bridge at Partridge Hollow needs repair
