- 3)- Our annual “wrapped and unwrapped” present raffle.



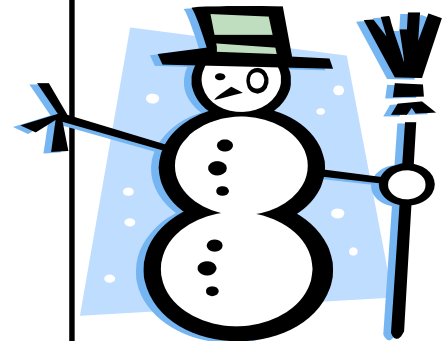
Please all bring a food item, a hot or cold dish, salad or desert. The club is providing coffee, soda, all utensils and
